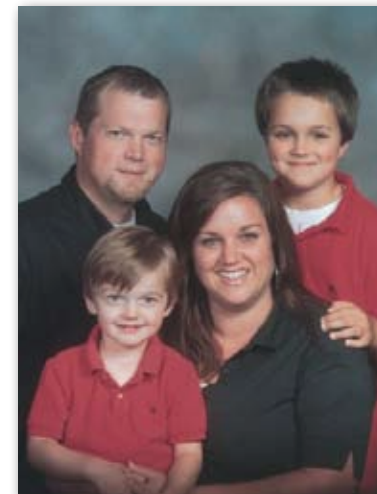
## Inclement Weather
