Approximately one year has passed since we began our renewed commitment to pay down our facilities debt. Our loan balance around one year ago was almost \$1.1 million, and we have just refinanced the loan at a balance of \$598,967.25! That is almost a 50% reduction in one year's time! During a season of economic hardship for so many, this accomplishment is amazing! God is Able!

A new five-year loan is again financed with First Citizens at an interest rate of 4%, and our new monthly payment is \$11,046. Of course, we hope to continue paying extra each month to see this debt reduced even more and, better yet, perhaps be totally eliminated by this time next year! We encourage everyone to remain faithful with your pledge commitments, stock gifts, and other types of contributions in order to see this debt retired! Again, God is Able!
